## COMPETITION TO NAME THE FIRST TEST VEHICLE

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS



#### 1. The Promoter

The promoter is:  
**AERALIS Ltd, Bury Lodge, Bury Road Stowmarket,  
Suffolk IP14 1JA**

#### 2. What is the Competition

- 2.1 The title of the competition is "Name the AERALIS First Flight Test Vehicle".
- 2.2 To enter the competition, suggest a name for the AERALIS First Flight Test Vehicle and an explanation of why you think it should be the name of the aircraft. Your explanation should not be more than 150 words.
- 2.3 The name (a) The name can be a single word, a short combination of words, or an acronym. (b) The name must not have been used for a past, current or proposed aircraft. (c) The name must not infringe a third party's intellectual property rights, including trademarks. (d) If named in honour of a person, that person must have died on or before July 1998 (e) The entrant should think about how the name might work globally.

#### 3. How to enter

- 3.1 The competition will run from 11am BST on 23rd August (the "Open Date") to 23:59pm BST on 30th September 2023 (the "Closing Date") inclusive.
- 3.2 All competition entries must be received by the Promoter by no later than 23:59 BST on the 30th September 2023 (the Closing Date) All competition entries received after the Closing Date are automatically disqualified.
- 3.3 Enter the competition online by submitting the online entry form provided on the AERALIS Website by Closing Date.
- 3.4 The Promoter will not accept: (a) responsibility for competition entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind; or (b) proof of posting or transmission as proof of receipt of entry to the competition.
- 3.5 By submitting a competition entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 3.6 The winning name will be notified by the end of October 2023 and the prize will be awarded at the AERALIS offices on the 8th November 2023.

#### 4. Judging the entries

- 4.1 AERALIS will appoint a judging panel. That panel will select a winning name from all the names

submitted. The decision of the panel of judges will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. If same winning name is submitted by multiple entrants, the winner will be selected randomly.

#### 5. Eligibility

- 5.1 The competition is only open to individuals resident in the UK who are current serving RAF Air Cadets and members of a UK Air Cadet Squadron.
- 5.2 Entrants aged under 18 years must provide signed approval of a parent or guardian before entering.
- 5.3 In entering the competition, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim the prize. The Promoter may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the competition.
- 5.4 There is a limit of one entry per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.
- 5.5 The Promoter reserves all rights to disqualify an entry if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize competition.
- 5.6 Only winning entrants will be directly notified of the results.

#### 6. The prize is

- 6.1 For the person submitting the winning entry:-
  - (i) to have your winning name painted on the first flight test vehicle and included in all press and publicity around the competition.  
  
The name will be given to the first flight test vehicle. There is no guarantee that the name will be used thereafter in the AERALIS Programme.
  - (ii) a unique souvenir poster to mark your success, signed by members of the AERALIS team including veteran RAF and test pilots
  - (iii) an AERALIS gift bundle
  - (iv) 2x invitations per year to visit our programme and witness the aircraft development up to first flight
  - (v) An invitation to sign your name on the first aircraft structure – together with our CEO and Test Pilot – during its assembly phase
- 6.2 And for your Unit:
  - (i) Your unit will be referenced in press and publicity around the competition

(ii) A unique certificate produced by AERALIS to mark your unit's success

(iii) Unique AERALIS Cadet T shirts

6.3 You will be responsible for ensuring that you and any person travelling with you are available to travel and hold valid passports, any necessary visas and travel documents.

6.4 There is no cash alternative for the prize.

6.5 The prize is not negotiable or transferable.

## **7. Announcements**

7.1 The Promoter will contact the winner personally as soon as practicable, using the email address provided with the competition entry. The Promoter will not amend any contact information once the competition entry form has been submitted.

## **8. Claiming the prize**

8.1 The prize may not be claimed by a third party on your behalf.

8.2 The Promoter will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If the winner cannot be contacted or is not available, or has not claimed their prize within 21 days from and including the date of notification (in accordance with 7.2 above), the Promoter reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the correct entries that were received before the Closing Date.

8.3 The Promoter does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the prize.

## **9. Limitation of liability**

9.1 To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

## **10. Ownership of competition entries and intellectual property rights**

10.1 All competition entries and any accompanying material submitted to the Promoter will become the property of the Promoter on receipt and will not be returned.

10.2 By submitting your competition entry and any accompanying material, you agree to: (a) assign to the Promoter all your intellectual property rights with full title guarantee; and (b) waive all moral rights, in and to your competition entry and otherwise arising in connection with your entry to which you may now or at any time in the future be entitled under the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988 as amended from time to time and under all similar legislation from time to time in force anywhere in the world.

10.3 You agree that the Promoter may, but is not required to, make your entry available on the AERALIS Website and any other media, whether now known or invented in the future, and in connection with any publicity of the competition. You agree to grant the Promoter a nonexclusive, worldwide, irrevocable licence, for the full period of any intellectual property rights in the competition entry, to use, display, publish, transmit, copy, edit, alter, store, re-format and sub-licence the competition entry for such purposes.

## **11. Data protection and publicity**

11.1 If you are the winner of the competition, you agree that the Promoter may use your name, image and town or county of residence to announce the winner of this competition and for any other reasonable and related promotional purposes.

11.2 You further agree to participate in any reasonable publicity required by the Promoter.

11.3 By entering the competition, you agree that any personal information provided by you with the competition entry may be held and used only by the Promoter or its agents and suppliers for the purposes of holding and managing a free and fair competition. It will not be retained thereafter or used for other purposes or shared with other parties.

## **12. General**

12.1 If there is any reason to believe that you are in breach of these terms and conditions, the Promoter may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the competition.

12.2 The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the prize competition where it becomes necessary to do so.

12.3 These terms and conditions shall be governed by English law, and the parties submit to the nonexclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
